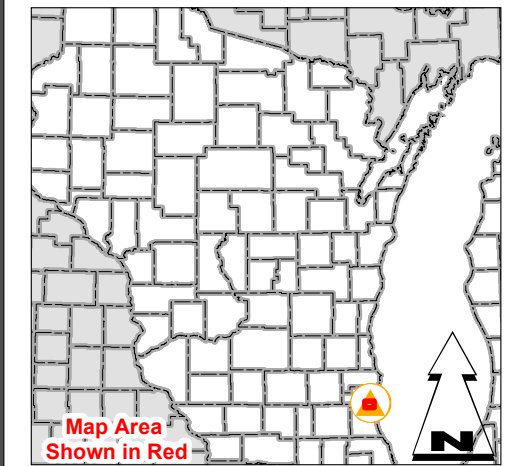


Two Wisconsin route alternatives are shown here in blue and green for a proposed double-circuit, 345-kilovolt electric transmission line that would connect an existing ATC transmission line in Pleasant Prairie, Wis., to ComEd's transmission system through a proposed substation in Newport Township, Ill. The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin will be asked to review both routes and approve one for construction. The Illinois Commerce Commission approved the purple route shown below.

Wisconsin - Illinois Reliability Project

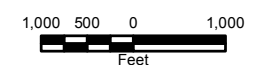
Final Route Alternatives and Substation Site
