Sturgeon Bay intersection closed for transmission line construction

Closure slated for Dec.8 and 9

PEWAUKEE, Wis. – The intersection of S. Neenah Avenue and W. Maple-Oregon Street will be closed to vehicle traffic for two days the week of Dec. 7 to allow for installation of new transmission line cables beneath the Sturgeon Bay Ship Channel.

- The intersection will be closed beginning at 7 a.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 8, 2020.
- The intersection is expected to be open by 11 p.m. on Wednesday, Dec. 9, 2020.

Local officials, along with local law enforcement, have been notified of the work. In the interest of safety, the public should remain a safe distance of 50 feet away from construction equipment and crews.
